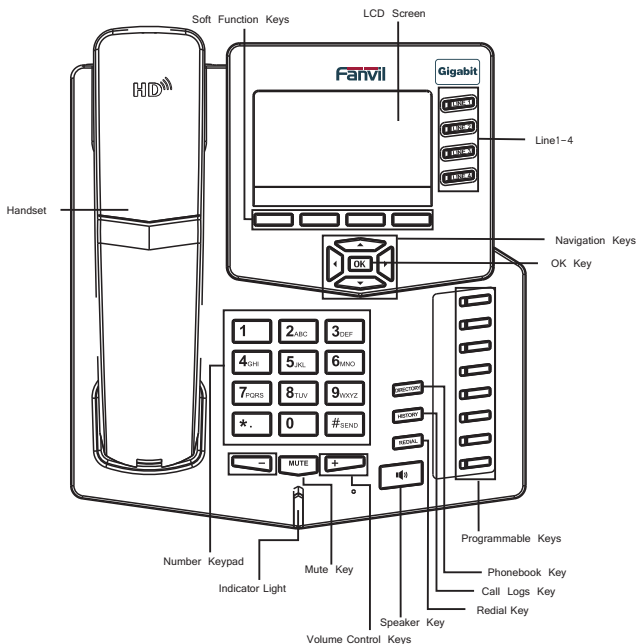

Front view and keypad function:

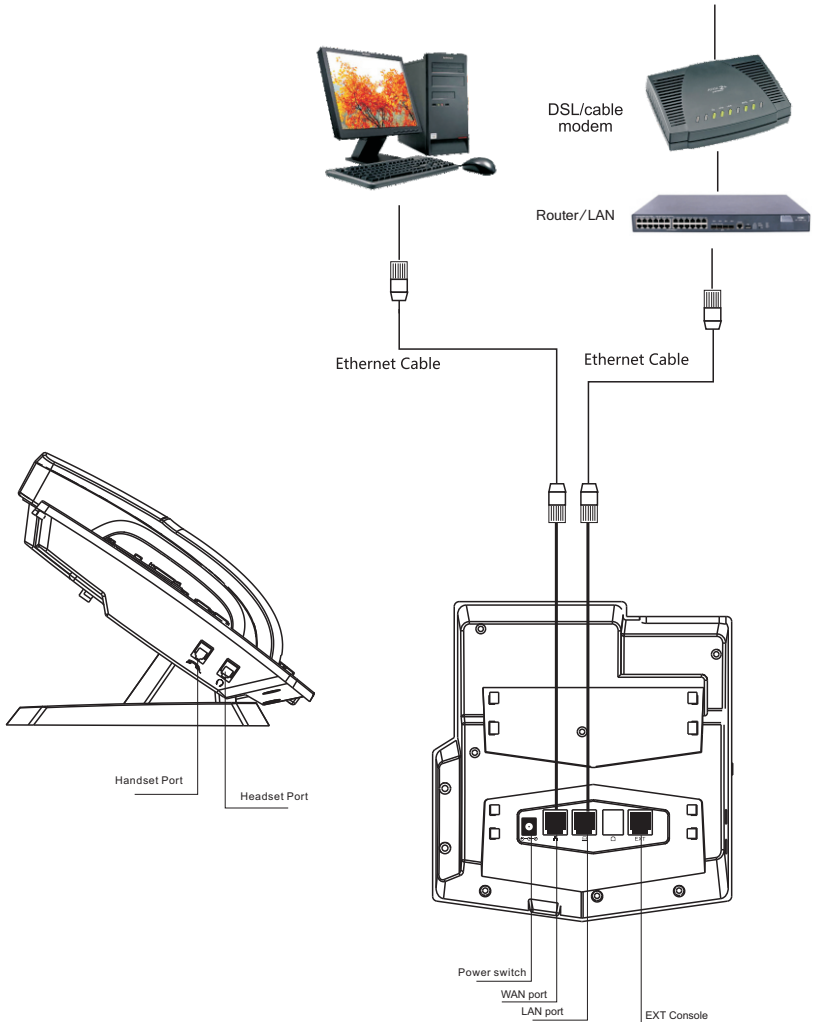


You can press these number keys one or more times to complete the corresponding input when you want do some input on the LCD.

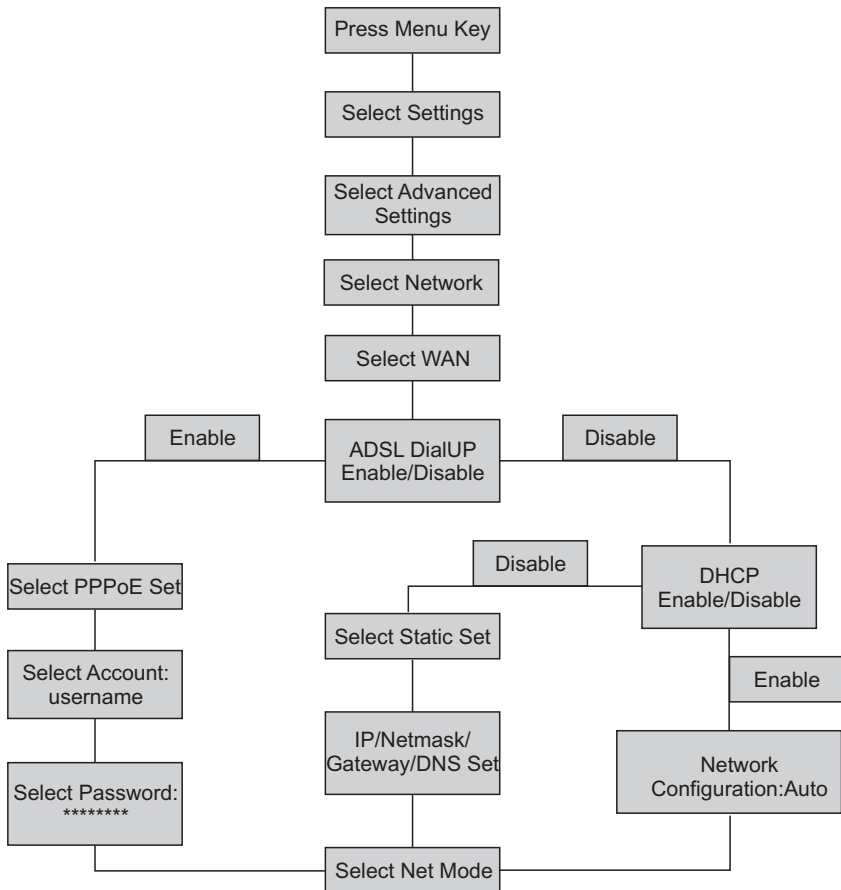

Connect the IP Phone as shown by the following diagram:



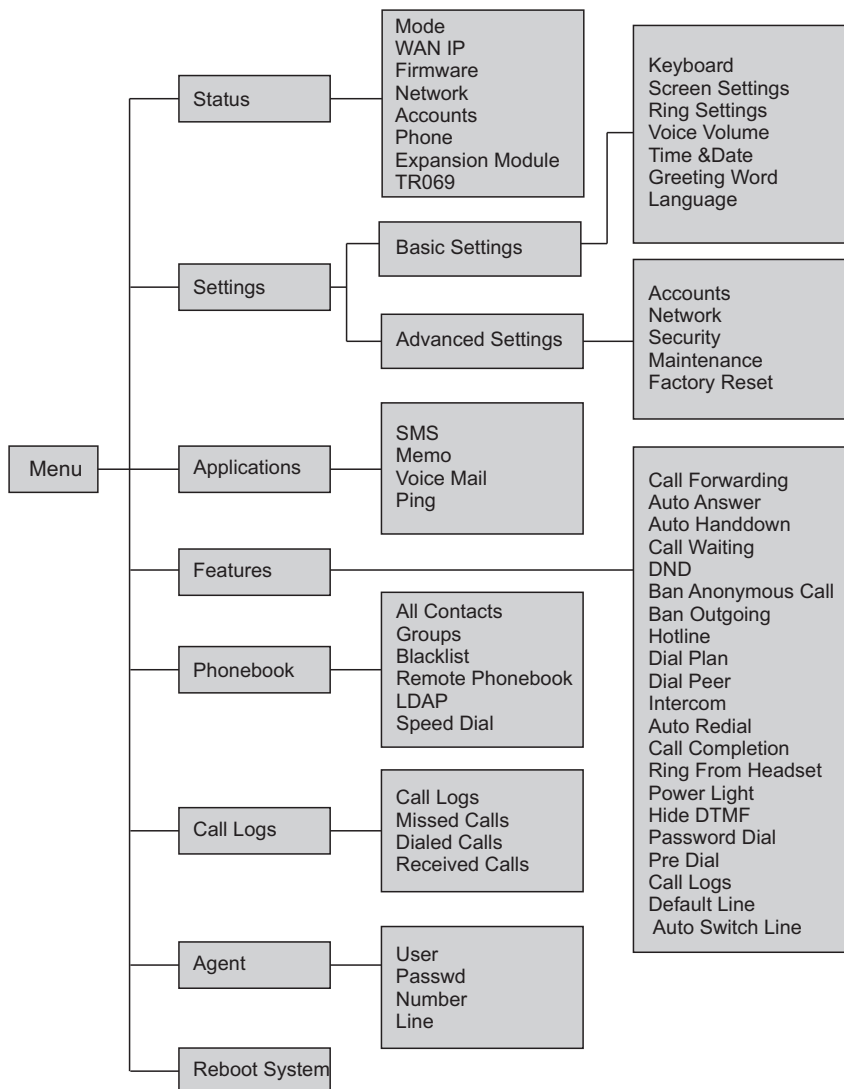
4 IP Phone Setup Menu(1)

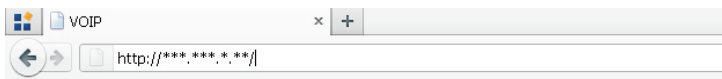
The menu of phone Structure:



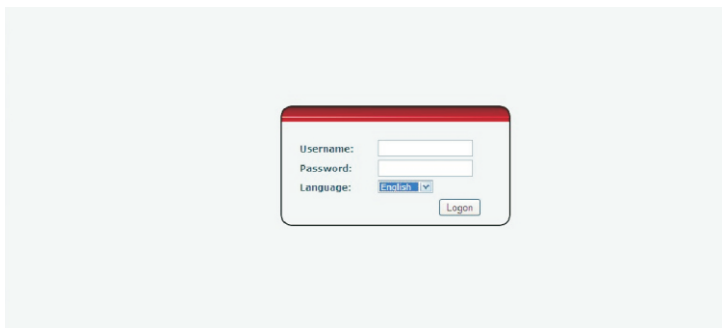

Web Login


The configuration menu of C66 can be accessed using the convenient and userfriendly interface of a web browser.

Network - PPPoE Setting

Select Network from the main menu.

Select PPPoE as network connection type if your ISP uses PPPoE. (Most DSL users use PPPoE.)

Make a Phone Call

IP Address:

1. Lift the handset or press the speaker button or headset button to enter the dialer interface.
2. Dial IP address.

For example: Input #192.168.0.1# in the dialer interface, will call the device whose IP address is 192.168.0.1.

SIP Number:

Note: You have to register with SIP server to use SIP number.

1. Lift the handset or press the speaker button or headset button to enter the dialer interface.
2. Dial SIP number.

For example: Input 1866

3. Press "#" button or wait until the timer expires.
